Subject: **Election of an Executive Director to Succeed Ms. Alisara Mahasandana—Voting Results**

The election of a successor to Ms. Mahasandana has been completed. In accordance with the procedures for the election (EBD/21/9, 3/23/21), Ms. Rosemary Lim of Singapore, the sole nominee, has been elected on May 21, 2021 to be Executive Director for the remainder of the term of Ms. Mahasandana. Ms. Lim will cast the votes allotted to Brunei Darussalam, Cambodia, Fiji, Indonesia, Lao People's Democratic Republic, Malaysia, Nepal, the Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, Tonga, and Vietnam<sup>1</sup>.

Ms. Lim will assume the functions of Executive Director on June 1, 2021. Members of the constituency will be notified accordingly. The correspondence on the election is available in the Secretary's Department.

<sup>1</sup> There is still lack of clarity whether Fund members representing a majority of the total voting power are recognizing or dealing with the new regime as the government of Myanmar. In light of this, and consistent with the Fund's approach in such cases, the Fund's engagement with the member will continue to be limited to low-level dealings with the new regime pending clarity regarding the views of the international community as represented by members representing a majority of the total voting power. Accordingly, Myanmar did not participate in the by-election of an Executive Director to succeed Ms. Mahasandana. However, as a result of the operation of the provisions governing by-elections, Myanmar would in any case formally remain a member of the constituency for the duration of the current Executive Board term, which will expire on October 31, 2022.
