An IMF team consisting of Messrs. Martin (head), Ebeke, and Nshimiyimana, and Mmes. Belianska (all AFR), Pico (FAD), and Popescu (SPR), held discussions with the Central African authorities from November 15–26, 2021. Messrs. Davies and Zoungarani (resident representative and local economist) helped organize the mission, while Mrs. Bah and Mr. Ondo Bile (OED) also attended the discussions.
