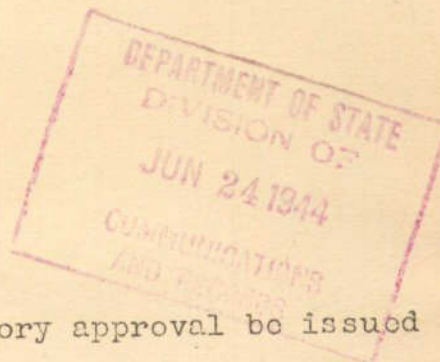

I strongly urge that advisory approval be issued immediately for visa to Hermann Max Coers. (Reference my telegrams' 1001, July 9, 5 p.m, and 1058, June 19, 1 p.m.).

Chilean Government is most desirous of having Max accompany its delegation to Monetary Conference and Embassy concurs for reasons stated in telegram 1001. One of the most valuable financial contacts would be lost to Embassy should favorable advisory opinion be withheld or further delayed.

Department's confidential telegrams June 3, 1 p.m. and June 10, 7 p.m. regarding the monetary and financial conference. Chilean delegation will leave Santiago June 21 and will enter at Miami probably June 23. President of delegation Luis Alamos Barros. Delegates Alfonso Fernandez Martorell, Arturo Mascke Tornero, and Fernando Mardones Restat. Auxiliary personnel will comprise 2 or 3, one of which will come from Chile and one or two from Chilean Embassy, Washington. All from Chile males. In addition rooms for delegation one big office needed for meetings. Arturo Mascke and one other (name unknown) will attend informal meeting Atlantic City, June 24. Mascke is manager Central Bank. Other detail follows.

Dr. Herrmann Max Coers born Germany March 19, 1893, residing Chile since 1925, has applied for visitor's visa to accompany Chilean delegation to International Monetary Conference as technical advisor. Dr. Max has been economist and technical advisor of Central Bank of Chile since 1929; is Professor of University of Chile and Rector of Institute of Studies on Banking. Applicant states he was naturalized as Chilean in 1932, his children born in Chile and his interests are here.

Doctor Max is well-known economist and financial authority, always has been friendly and cooperative with Embassy and American business interest in Chile, and has many Pro-Allied friends.

It is especially recommended that favourable advisory opinion be issued as early as possible since delegation departing within a few days.

FROM TREASURY



Provision IV-4 of the Joint Statement permits a country, after consultation with the Fund, to change the initial parity of its currency by not more than 10 percent. (Your 861) Further changes are not limited, but require approval of the Fund. In cases where the requested change in parity does not exceed 10 percent, the Fund will give its decision within two days of receiving the application. Where a country requires a change in the parity of its currency to restore equilibrium, the Fund is fully authorized to approve whatever change in parity is necessary for this purpose.

Reference is made to the Department's telegram of April 18, 1944, 8 p.m. requesting me to communicate to the Minister of Finance of the Chilean Government and to Sr. Fernando Illanes, the Chilean Representative at the Washington Conference for Monetary Stabilization, the message of the Secretary of the Treasury regarding the proposals for international monetary cooperation.
