

A BILL

Making appropriations for the participation by the United States in the International Monetary Fund and the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That there is hereby appropriated out of the sum appropriated by subsection (b) of Section 10 of the Gold Reserve Act of 1934, 48 Stat. 341 (U.S.C. title 31, Sec. 822a), as amended, \$1,800,000,000 to be used as follows:

(a) \$1,736,500,000 to be paid to the International Monetary Fund as part of the subscription of the United States, of which \$687,500,000 shall be paid in gold; and

(b) \$63,500,000 to be paid in gold to the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development as part of the subscription of the United States.

Any repayment by the International Monetary Fund or the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development, to the extent of \$1,800,000,000, shall be credited to the fund established in Section 10 of the Gold Reserve Act of 1934, 48 Stat. 341 (U.S.C. title 31, sec. 822a).
