I called Mr. Baron of the Cuban Embassy to inquire whether he had had further word from the government of Cuba on signing the Bretton Woods Agreements. Mr. Baron said he had not. I told him that it is important that Cuba be prepared to sign the Agreements in Washington and I suggested to him that he inform his government of the need to make available the one hundredth of one percent that must be transmitted at the time of the signing and that a representative in Washington be designated to sign the Agreements on behalf of Cuba.

Mr. Baron said he would send the telegram immediately.
