Invitation to attend meeting Board of Governors of bank under Bretton Woods Agreement delivered Foreign Minister this morning. He appreciated invitation and accepts same. He also expressed regret that until constitutional assembly acts, Panama could not complete arrangements for membership under agreement. However, he feels that this matter will be cleared up at an early date. Foreign Minister agreed to advise me of maximum number of persons etc. that will attend. At least two with small staff is best estimate at this time. Further details requested in telegram will be transmitted to you promptly.
