Senate Saturday confirmed nomination of Arturo Maschke as Chilean Governor of Bretton Woods Fund and Bank. Luis Davila also confirmed as alternate both posts (EMBTTEL 106, Jan 28 and DEPCIRTEL twenty-sixth). Accommodations for only two Chileans will be required Wilmington Island, Maschke proceeding alone from Chile neut is asking Foreign Office to assign secretary Chilean Embassy, Washington to assist him at conference. Will wire Maschke's itinerary later.

Chilean delegation provisionally not expected exceed three persons. Arturo Maschke, Manager Central Bank, has been nominated as Chilean governor both boards. Luis Davila, Assistant Manager Central Bank, nominated alternate. Neither nomination yet confirmed by Senate but expected soon.
