

Mt. Washington Hotel— Picked For Conference

Bretton Woods, N. H., May 27 (AP)—The International Monetary Conference scheduled for July 1 will be held in the 400-room Mount Washington Hotel in the Presidential range of the White Mountains, which was once the Mecca of American and European celebrities.

A director of the corporation which bought the 15 square miles of forest and 47 buildings making up the hotel property said: "We were assigned the conference within the past 48 hours."

The main hotel is five stories high. On the grounds are a smaller hotel, Bretton Arms; a 250-car garage, stables that accommodate 200 horses, dormitories, two swimming pools, two golf courses (18 and 9 holes) and a field, one church.

Built in 1902, the hotel was untenanted for the past two years.
