The attention of the Eire Government is invited to resolution VI of the United Nations Monetary and Financial Conference Bretton Woods in July 1944 and to the declaration of London of January 5, 1943. These declarations have already been communicated to the Eire Government whose cooperation is now requested for the purpose of implementing them.

The Allied powers are confident that the Eire Government will afford the necessary assistance by subscribing to these declarations and by taking steps, by legislation or otherwise, to secure their primary object which is the identification and freezing in neutral countries of all property in which there is an enemy interest pending a final disposition of German and Japanese assets by the Allied powers.

This purpose would be achieved by the Eire Government taking the following measures:

(A) The freezing of all assets belonging to individuals living in Japan Germany and all territories formerly occupied by the Axis powers which are held by or through neutrals.

(B) The furnishing of a complete listing or census of all such frozen assets.

(C) The setting up of controls which would effectively prevent the entry into Axis countries or Axis controlled countries of property now in neutral countries owned by nationals of such Axis countries or Axis controlled countries.

(D) The furnishing of all information derived from the above procedures.

(E) Consultation with the Allied powers regarding the Licensing of transactions which might affect the disposition of assets frozen by the above procedures.
