Your circular telegrams of 17th October

A press release containing the text of the Department's October 4 press release regarding resolution of Bretton Woods was sent by Legation on November 2 to the three Dublin newspapers. None of these papers mentioned the release or its subject.

We have learned in confidence that at least one of the papers decided to print out the release in its entirety but that such action was not permitted by press censor. It is presumed that the same prohibition was imposed on the other two papers but official notice that the item was banned has not been received. Therefore, we are publishing it in the next weeks issue of the letter from America but other means of giving the resolution proper publicity do not exist. Representative of British here is in agreement with me that it was advisable to try to give it publicity.
