A:459, October 5, 6 p.m. 1944. In a Foreign Office Note dated October 4, I have been informed that the Guatemalan Government has instructed its Charges d'Affaires at Lisbon and Madrid to deliver notes similar to that quoted in the Department's Circular Telegram of September 29, 9 p.m., calling upon those Governments to institute measures to assist the United Nations in carrying out the objects of Resolution VI of the Bretton Woods Conference. Guatemala is represented only in the two neutral countries mentioned.
