

PARAPHRASE OF TELEGRAM COPY

FROM: Secretary of State, Washington
TO: AMERICAN EMBASSY, MOSCOW
DATED: September 18, 1944

SECRET

See message 2135 from the Department of the fifth of September.

Our missions in the neutral capitals are being given instructions to withhold presentation of the proposed note until the Department transmits further instructions, in light of discussions being held at this time with the British concerning the possibility for joint representations with regard to the Bretton Woods Resolution number six. A tentative and preliminary draft note has been submitted by the British, however, this note has not as yet been cleared in all interested departments of the Government of Britain. The foregoing sentence is for your information. Within the next week or ten days it is hoped that we can reach an agreement and that a joint note can be presented.
