Reference Department's circular airgram August 19, and circular telegram of September 29, 5:00 p.m., regarding Resolution VI adopted at the United Nations Monetary and Financial Conference at Bretton Woods.

In reply to my Note to the Ministry of State of September 30, 1944, in the sense of the airgram and telegram above-mentioned, I have received an answer dated October 7, the substantive portion of which reads in translation as follows:

"In reply I am pleased to advise Your Excellency that the Government of the Republic, considering the importance of Resolution VI, accepts in principle the points of view of Your Excellency's Government in respect thereof. These points of view will be the subject of later consideration by the experts of the appropriate branches of the Government."
