

PARAPHRASE OF TELEGRAM RECEIVED

FROM: American Embassy, La Paz.
TO: Secretary of State, Washington.

SECRET

The implementation of Resolution 6 of the Conference at Bretton Woods was yesterday discussed by me with Andrade (see telegram Number 1751 dated October 3, 1944, from the Embassy). Just as soon as the Embassy can indicate clearly to him what it is desired that his Government do, Andrade will inform me of the steps that will be taken by Bolivia in cooperation. Andrade stated that he was doubtful that the cooperation of Bolivia could be fully effective, since that country has only a few representatives abroad.
