Embassy unable to act on Department's instruction concerning Bretton Woods resolution number six (reference Department's circular instruction September 29, 6 p.m.) because instructions are not clear and it is feared some are lacking.

Department indicates Government endorses resolution number six and has called upon European neutral countries. Is it Department's desire that Bolivia act under recommendations of resolution number six and call upon neutral European countries mentioned Department's circular instruction September 29, or is it desired that Bolivia call upon all neutrals including Argentina. Because of lack of clarity Department's instructions as received here it might be more satisfactory for Department to prepare the memorandum in the premises which it is desired be delivered to Bolivian Government.
