Subject: Bretton Woods Resolution VI.

Reference Department's circular telegram of September 29, 6 p.m.

The action of the United States Government in endorsing Resolution VI of the United Nations Monetary and Financial Conference at Bretton Woods was brought to the attention of the Secretary General of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs on October 3, 1944. (It had been impossible to arrange an earlier appointment at the Foreign Office.) At the same time the Secretary General was shown the text of the telegraphic instructions sent to diplomatic missions at Bern, Stockholm, Dublin, Lisbon, Madrid, Tangiers, and Ankara. It was pointed out that any parallel action which the Colombian Government might wish to take in the matter would of course be welcome.

Dr. URANA Bernal expressed appreciation for this information, but did not at the time indicate specifically whether or not Colombia would take similar action.
