CONFIDENTIAL

We refer to message from the Embassy dated October 25, Number 3250.

The comment of the Prime Minister with reference to our notes on Resolution 6, Bretton Woods (according to the Brazilian Charge d'Affaires who talked with Salazar privately on the fourth of November) was to the effect that the Government of Portugal would be prepared to examine practical measures which might be advanced by the Allies for attaining the objectives of the Resolution.

That Salazar has not attached much importance to the notes was the impression of Ribeiro Couto.
