PARAPHRASE OF TELEGRAM SENT

SECRET

The following message is from FEA and the Department. It was repeated as Department's 2569 to Stockholm.

Reference Stockholm's 5105, December 13 (repeated as 1652 to London); Department's 10495, December 16 (repeated as 2535 to Stockholm); Stockholm's 5170, December 18 (repeated as 1673 to London); Embassy's 11227, December 18 (repeated as 854 to Stockholm).

The Department makes the recommendation that detailed steps to implement Bretton Woods Resolution No. 6 as suggested in Stockholm's 5105 should not now be discussed with Boheman.

We anticipate recommending approach to the Swedish Government through the American Legation, Stockholm, with detailed formulations in full including, it is likely, those which the American Legation, Stockholm, recommended, after Boheman has agreed with the general statement on Bretton Woods Resolution as reworded in Department's 10495. We are now preparing here the detailed recommendations.
