Sec. In the realization that additional measures of international economic cooperation are necessary to facilitate the expansion and balanced growth of international trade and render most effective the operations of the Fund and the Bank, it is hereby declared to be the policy of the United States to seek to bring about further agreement and cooperation among nations and international bodies, as soon as possible on ways and means which will best reduce obstacles to and restrictions upon international trade, promote mutually advantageous commercial relations, and otherwise facilitate the expansion and balanced growth of international trade and promote the stability of international economic relations.

In the realization that additional measures of international economic cooperation are necessary to facilitate the expansion and balanced growth of international trade and the successful achievement of the purposes of the Fund and the Bank, it is hereby declared to be the policy of the United States to seek to bring about further agreements and cooperation among nations and international bodies, as soon as possible on ways and means which will best ~~bring about further~~

- (1) Reduce obstacles to and restrictions upon international trade and in other ways promote mutually advantageous commercial relations;
- (2) Deal with special economic problems of international concern arising out of the war; and
- (3) Otherwise facilitate the expansion and balanced growth of international trade and promote the stability of international economic relations.
