MODERN ANNOTATED FORMS OF AGREEMENT

Employment Agreements

That if, by reason of mental or physical disability, or otherwise, the Second Party shall be incapacitated from fully complying with each and all of his obligations herein set forth, then, and thereupon, this agreement shall be suspended both as to services and compensation during the period of such disability or incapacity, except as herein otherwise provided in the next succeeding subparagraph marked "(b)"; and the term of this agreement and of all the provisions herein contained, shall be extended, at the option of the First Party, for a period equal to the period of such suspension, by the service of written notice of the exercise of such option upon the Second Party.
