Employment Agreements

Clause providing employee shall not disclose information obtained during employment. 1

That the Employee covenants that he will not, during or after his employment, disclose any information obtained by him while in the employ of the Employer to any person not employed by the Employer (and the term "person" shall be deemed to include an association, partnership or corporation), without the prior written consent of an officer of the Employer.
