

Treasury Officer To Speak at V.U. Tuesday Night

Dr. Roman L. Horne, representative of the United States Treasury Department, Washington, D. C., will speak on the Bretton Woods Agreement Tuesday night at Vanderbilt University under the auspices of the newly organized United Nations Association of Nashville.

Dr. Horne, a technical assistant in the Division of Monetary Research of the Treasury Department, will speak at 8 o'clock Tuesday night at Alumni Memorial Hall on the campus. His duties are in connection with the presentation of the Bretton Woods Monetary program before Congress and the public.

He entered government service in 1934 and was connected with the Federal Reserve Board until 1940, when he became chief reports editor of the Tennessee Valley Authority.

The United Nations Association of Nashville is affiliated with the American Association for the United Nations (former League of Nations association) and the Southern Council of Foreign Relations, with Fyke Farmer, president of the local organization.
