

Bretton Woods Bills Face Delay in Congress

today that the Bretton Woods measures, no matter what their final make-up, could not possibly be pushed through Congress before July 1.

Representative Wolcott (Mich.), ranking minority member of the House banking committee, said hearings will not be resumed before April 16, despite the fact that the House will reconvene on April 10.

The committee will require about two weeks, perhaps more, to complete its hearings. It will be about 10 days more before the bill is reported out. There is no indication when the Senate banking committee will begin its hearings.
