**AFL PRESIDENT
URGES AMENDED
MONETARY PLAN**

Washington, D. C., April 29 (AP)—William Green, AFL president, has urged congress to approve the Bretton Woods monetary proposals after adding provisions he said would protect labor. Terming the plans of "vital importance" in implementing the proposed peace keeping organization, Green suggested to the house banking committee that these two policy declarations be inserted:

1. That consultation with the international labor organizations be made a basic administrative procedure before deciding on use of funds.

2. That the recipient of bank loans be required to guarantee observance of prevailing wages and hours, safety and health standards, and general standards recommended by the I.L.O.

Sen. Thomas [D., Okla.] said earlier he would propose amendments calling for inclusion of silver and use of a theoretical gold coin as a world monetary unit.
