Treasury's Name Used By Reds Here for Drive

One of the slickest acts of hocus-pocus the Communists ever used here has just come to light with the discovery that for a week they have been using the name of the Treasury Department to put across a rally here Sunday which has for its real purpose the launching of a drive to raise funds for the official organ, the Daily Worker.

The rally at Tom Mooney Hall, 13 Astor Pl., "is specifically to give impetus to the financial drive," said an editorial in the Daily Worker yesterday. "No less of a contribution to an understanding of issues will be made by Arthur C. Bunce of the Treasury Department," it added.

The Communists have been playing up the participation of the Treasury official as main speaker for the rally "to talk on Bretton Woods."

How come, was the question put to Randolph Filtus, technical assistant to Secretary Morgenthau. Filtus explained the department at no time knew the tieup between the fund drive and the rally. He said he would call the Worker and tell them "we are not furnishing or sponsoring the speaker."

"We are not going to take part in any fund raising campaign, whether for the Republicans, Democrats or Communists," he said.
