

**A. F. L. Asks Safeguards
In Bretton Woods Pact**

WASHINGTON, April 27.—(UP)—William Green, president of the American Federation of Labor, asked Congress today to amend the Bretton Woods international monetary agreements to provide for improved world labor standards.

He appeared before the House banking committee to urge ratification of the agreements, with the proposed protection for labor and with a provision similar to the compromise formula devised by the Committee for Economic Development, a business organization. The Congress of Industrial Organizations also has endorsed the agreements.

Green said the International Labor Organization should be authorized to protect labor interests in connection with the operation of the monetary stabilization fund and the international bank proposed in the Bretton Woods agreements.
