Mr. Bunce learned yesterday that he couldn't keep the date, according to Mr. Filtus, so the Treasury gave the Worker the name of seven other possible speakers over the telephone. The one who agreed to substitute was Dr. Mabel Newcomer, economist of Vassar College, who was this government's only woman delegate to the United Nations Monetary and Financia Conference last year.

Speaker To Be Warned.

"I will also call Professor New-comer," Mr. Filtus said, "and tell her if she goes to the meeting it will be on her own responsibility and not as a representative of the Treasury Department.

"I want to make it plain no one had any authority to say the Treasury was furnishing a 'main 'speaker.' Neither Mr. Bunce nor Dr. Newcomer would be going at

the behest of the Treasury."

The Daily Worker last month announced formation of a Sponsoring Committee of the Daily Worker 1945 Fund Campaign, headed by Rockwell Kent and composed mostly of party stal-warts and open fellow travelers, warts and open fellow travelers, such as Dr. Bella V. Dodd, Max Bedacht, Rep. A. Clayton Powell Jr., Frederick V. Field, Dr. Harry F. Ward and the Rev. William Howard Melish of the Church of the Holy Tristing Procedure.
