Subject: Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) - Request  
for Reports on Recent Economic Developments

Pursuant to the decision of the Executive Board giving the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) access to certain reports on recent economic developments in order to assist in a major study of agricultural and food price policy, a FAO team has examined data from the 40 countries listed in EBD/84/89 (3/20/84). A lack of data prevented the team from including Algeria, Fiji, and Venezuela, as had been indicated initially, and the FAO would wish to substitute Cameroon, Jamaica, and Yemen Arab Republic for those countries in its study. It is proposed, therefore, that the FAO researchers be permitted access to reports of the recent economic developments for these countries in accordance with the procedure previously agreed by the Executive Board.

In the absence of an objection from an Executive Director by noon on Monday, April 23, 1984, the proposal will be deemed approved by the Executive Board and it will be so recorded in the minutes of the next meeting thereafter.
