Subject: Kingdom of the Netherlands - Netherlands Antilles -  
Technical Assistance

As indicated in EBD/83/312 (12/2/84), a staff mission visited the Netherlands Antilles to advise on the establishment of a Central Bank for Aruba within a Monetary Union with the remaining five islands. The report of the advisory mission which visited Curaçao and Aruba in January 1984 has now been completed. A second visit referred to in the above paper will now be undertaken in mid-April for one week for further discussions with the authorities. The mission will comprise Mr. Hassanali Mehran, Advisor, Central Banking Department (Head); Ms. Philine R. Lachman, Assistant General Counsel, Legal Department; Mr. Mohammad R. Vaez-Zadeh, Economist, Central Banking Department; and Mrs. Purisima N. Anderson, Secretary, Central Banking Department.
