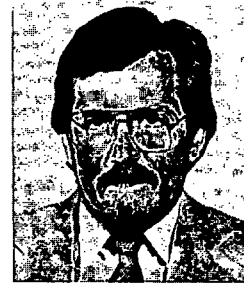

THEORY

The theory of the present experiment is based on the fact that the rate of change of the concentration of a reactant is proportional to the rate of change of the concentration of a product. This is expressed mathematically as follows:

$$\frac{d[A]}{dt} = -\frac{d[B]}{dt}$$

where $[A]$ is the concentration of the reactant, $[B]$ is the concentration of the product, and t is time. The negative sign indicates that the concentration of the reactant decreases as the concentration of the product increases.

The rate of change of the concentration of a reactant can be determined by measuring the change in the concentration of a product over a known period of time. This is done by measuring the change in the absorbance of a solution containing the product.

EXPERIMENT

The experiment was carried out using a spectrophotometer to measure the absorbance of a solution containing the product. The absorbance was measured at regular intervals of time, and the change in absorbance was used to determine the rate of change of the concentration of the product. The rate of change of the concentration of the reactant was then determined using the equation above.
