Subject: Malta - Change in Name of Currency

The Government of Malta has notified the Fund that the name of its currency should be recorded as "lira," which is the same in both singular and plural form. The symbol and adjective for the currency have also been changed. The new symbol is "Lm," and the adjective is now "Maltese."

Previously, the name of the currency of Malta was "pound," with symbol "£M" and adjective "Malta."
