Subject: Designation Plan for December 1983-February 1984

Attached for consideration by the Executive Directors is the proposed designation plan for the quarterly period December 1983-February 1984, together with explanatory comments by the staff. A draft decision appears on page 3.

It is proposed that this subject be brought to the agenda for discussion on Friday, December 16, 1983. Consideration of the designation plan by the Executive Board will be immediately followed by consideration of the operational budget (EBS/83/259, 12/2/83).

Introduction

1. The designation plan proposed for the quarterly period December 1983 - February 1984 is set out in Table 1. The total of the proposed plan is SDR 1,500 million, distributed among 16 participants. The plan is derived from the calculation of designation amounts in Table 2, which lists those participants whose balance of payments and reserve positions are considered at this time to be sufficiently strong for them to be subject to designation in accordance with Article XIX, Section 5(a)(i).

2. Data relevant to the assessment of members' balance of payments and reserve positions are set out in Appendix Table 1, which shows the latest available data for all Fund members as background for both the designation plan and the operational budget.

List of Participants

3. Compared with the list on which the plan for September - November 1983 was based, the list of participants in Table 2 includes Belgium, Denmark and Ireland in view of developments in their combined balance of payments and reserve positions.

4. The list of participants in Table 1 differs from the list in Table 2 because (a) Colombia and Japan are not assigned designation amounts because their excess holding ratios are above the common ratio of 6.65 yielded by the calculation described below, and (b) five participants' SDR holdings are close to or above their acceptance limits. These participants are Kuwait, Malta, Oman, Saudi Arabia and Singapore.

Plan Amount and Method of Calculation

5. The proposed plan is based on a total of SDR 1,500 million, the same amount as is proposed for inclusion in the operational budget for December 1983 - February 1984 for transfers to members making

purchases from the Fund. The need for many purchasing members to retain some amount of SDRs for charges due to the Fund should mean that transactions with designation arising from purchases will be sufficiently below the maximum of SDR 1,500 million to provide an adequate margin in the plan for the possible use of SDRs in designation by participants from their own holdings. It cannot, of course, be predicted whether this margin will be sufficient to cover all transactions with designation that might arise. If at any time the remaining balance in the plan seemed insufficient, the staff would propose an amendment to the plan. In these circumstances, in order to assure the liquidity of the SDR in transactions with designation, it may be necessary to request the Executive Board to approve an amendment at short notice, particularly if a large transaction were to occur.

6. The amounts of designation for individual participants (see Table 2) have been calculated in the usual way. 1/ A notional amount for the coming two years, taken as five times the amount of the proposed quarterly plan, was distributed among the participants listed so that their excess holdings ratios were brought up to a common ratio for all the participants in the plan. The amounts assigned to individual participants were then proportionately reduced so that they would sum to the total amount of the proposed plan. 2/ As already noted, Kuwait, Malta, Oman, Saudi Arabia and Singapore have not been included in the calculation of designation amounts in Table 2 because their SDR holdings are at or above their acceptance limits.

1/ Under Schedule F, the rules for designation require that participants shall be designated for such amounts as will promote over time equality in their excess holdings ratios, that is, their holdings of SDRs in excess of their net cumulative allocations expressed as a percentage of their official holdings of gold and foreign exchange. The Executive Board reviewed the principles and procedures for designation in July 1979 and generally shared the staff's conclusion that no changes were necessary (see SM/79/183, discussed at EBM/79/124 on July 25, 1979). A further review was conducted by the Executive Board at EBM/81/37 on March 2, 1981 and again it was decided that no changes were needed for the time being.

2/ At the start of the December 1982 - February 1983 quarterly period, an issue arose on the definition of reserves being supplied to the IFS by the U.A.E., whose position was judged at that time to be sufficiently strong. As reported last quarter, the issue of the definition has been resolved, although the latest data based on that definition is still not available. The calculated amount of designation continues to be based on data for October 1982, which is the most recent IFS statistic. As was the case for the previous plan, it is proposed that as soon as the technical questions have been resolved, the amount of designation for the United Arab Emirates and the total of the plan, would be amended to reflect the use of more recent data on the new basis. On the basis of information at hand, this is expected to reduce the amount for the U.A.E. from SDR 30.5 million to about SDR 22 million. The amounts for other members in the plan would be left unchanged.

Execution of Proposed Plan

7. In accordance with the usual practice, it is proposed to execute the proposed plan by designating individual participants in broad proportion to the amounts for which they are included in the plan while avoiding undue fragmentation of individual transactions. However, a participant that is included for SDR 2 million or less may be designated in a single transaction for the full amount for which it is included in the plan. 1/

Recommended Decision

8. The following draft decision on a matter pertaining exclusively to the Special Drawing Rights Department is proposed for adoption by the Executive Board:

The Executive Board approves the designation plan for the quarterly period beginning December , 1983 as set out in EBS/83/258.

1/ The execution of the plan for September - November 1983 is shown in Table 3. The total amount used as of November 28, 1983 (including pending items) was equivalent to SDR 644.14 million. Eleven participants receiving SDRs in purchases from the Fund used SDR 610.14 million in transactions with designation. The balance of SDR 34 million represented use from existing SDR holdings.
