Subject: Increases in Quotas of Fund Members - Eighth General Review

In accordance with the decision of the Executive Board adopted at Executive Board Meeting 83/39, February 25, 1983, the Secretary has canvassed the votes cast by Governors on the Resolution submitted to the Board of Governors on February 28, 1983, with respect to Increases in Quotas of Fund Members - Eighth General Review.

The voting has been completed. Under Section 13 of the By-Laws, the replies of a majority of Governors (74), exercising two thirds (431,399) of the total voting power (647,098) are required for a quorum. Furthermore, 85 per cent (550,034) of the total voting power must be in favor of the Resolution for its adoption pursuant to Article III, Section 2(c). These requirements have been met. A total of 640,517 votes, 98.98 per cent of the total voting power, was validly cast by 135 members in favor of the Resolution. The votes of each member are shown in the attachment. Accordingly, the Resolution is adopted by the Board of Governors, effective March 31, 1983. The Resolution will be designated No. 38-1.

The ballots and all correspondence relating to the voting are available for inspection in the Secretary's Department.

Unless an Executive Director requests that this matter be placed on the agenda, this report will be deemed approved as of 3:00 p.m. today, Friday, April 1, 1983. The time of 3:00 p.m. is suggested in order to permit a wider dissemination of the press release than would be possible if the lapse-of-time period extended through the close of business. Members will be informed of the result, and the Executive Board's approval will be recorded in the minutes of the next meeting thereafter.
