Subject: Peru - Request for a Fund Representative

The Committee on Administrative Policies has approved the proposal set forth in the attached memorandum to establish a Fund resident representative post in Peru. The Committee recommends that the resident post be established as an addition to the 23 posts included in the amended ceiling for FY 1984 (EBAP/83/265, 10/28/83). As a result, the overall staff ceiling for FY 1984 would also be raised from 1,608 to 1,609.

In the absence of objection by the close of business on Tuesday, November 8, 1983, the recommendation of the Committee will be deemed approved by the Executive Board and it will be so recorded in the minutes of the next meeting thereafter.

SUBJECT : Peru--Request for a Fund Representative

DATE: October 27, 1983

The authorities of Peru have requested the posting of a Fund representative to Lima, Peru to assist them in implementing and monitoring progress under the program supported by the extended arrangement.

Subject to approval of the proposal of a resident representative's post for Zambia (EB/CAP/83/8), which is currently before the Committee, the establishment of a post in Peru would exceed the amended ceiling of 23 such posts.

It is recommended, therefore, that the post be established as an addition to the proposed number for the FY 1984 budget. As a result, the overall staff ceiling for FY 1984 would be raised from 1608 to 1609. In accordance with established practice, the Peruvian authorities would be requested to make a contribution toward the cost of this post in the form of office space, secretarial assistance, and an official car.
