The Chairman of the International Monetary Fund's Interim Committee, Sir Geoffrey Howe, Chancellor of the Exchequer of the United Kingdom, has, in consultation with the Managing Director, proposed that its next meeting be convened in Washington, D.C., on February 10 and 11, 1983. Since the Interim Committee last met in Toronto, the Fund's Executive Board has been considering the provision of additional resources for the Fund. The Interim Committee had decided to meet again in April so that remaining issues relating to the Eighth General Review of Quotas could be resolved. However, in view of the progress made, and the priority the Chairman attaches to strengthening the Fund's resources, he has proposed that the next meeting be convened on the earlier dates.
