The Government of Antigua and Barbuda has formally notified the International Monetary Fund that it has accepted the obligations of Article VIII, Sections 2, 3, and 4. of the Fund's Articles of Agreement.

Members accepting the obligations of Article VIII undertake not to impose restrictions on payments and transfers for current international transactions or engage in multiple exchange practices or discriminatory currency arrangements, and to assure convertibility of their currencies.

Antigua and Barbuda, which joined the Fund on February 25, 1982, is the fifty-ninth member of the Fund to assume Article VIII status.
