The People's Republic of Mozambique today became a member of the International Monetary Fund and the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (World Bank). The new member's quota in the Fund is SDR 61 million; its subscription to the capital of the World Bank is 272 shares with a total value of SDR 27.2 million.

Membership of the two organizations now totals 148 countries, and with the admission of Mozambique, the total of members' quotas in the Fund is SDR 89,301.8 million, while the total authorized capital in the World Bank is SDR 78,650 million.
