In the attached letter dated December 6, 2000, the Yemeni authorities are requesting a further extension to March 1, 2001, of the PRGF commitment period for the Republic of Yemen which is due to expire on December 31, 2000 (EBS/00/205, 10/12/00). The EFF commitment period was already extended to March 1, 2001 in the context of the second review (EBS/99/25).
2. The extension is needed to enable consideration of a request for a third annual arrangement under the PRGF. This request had been delayed in part by disagreements over the pace and scope of diesel price increases. Consideration of the request is now contingent on finalization of a program for 2001. Parliamentary approval of a GST Law, and agreement on procedures to ensure the 2001 budget recently approved by parliament is executed consistent with the parameters of the program, are prior actions for Executive Board consideration of the request. When making the request for the third annual arrangement, the authorities also intend to request a further extension of the commitment period to October 28, 2001.
3. The staff supports the authorities' request for an extension of the PRGF commitment period to March 1, 2001.

Accordingly, the following decision is being proposed for adoption by the Executive Board:

**Proposed Decision**

The Republic of Yemen has requested an extension to March 1, 2001 of the PRGF commitment period set forth in EBS/97/172, Supplement 3 (10/31/97).

The PRGF commitment period for Yemen is extended to March 1, 2001.
