Eighth General Review of Quotas - Proposed Maximum Quotas

1. In connection with the Seventh General Review of Quotas, the proposed maximum quotas up to which members could consent were rounded to the next higher multiple of SDR 100,000. Following the practice of the last Review, the proposed maximum quotas shown in the Annex have been rounded to the next higher multiple of SDR 100,000. The rounding up of all quotas in this manner will raise the overall size of the Fund to SDR 90,005.8 million, excluding Democratic Kampuchea for which no quota calculations were made in connection with the Eighth General Review. The proposed maximum quotas of individual members are shown in the Annex. ^{1/} The proposed maximum quotas of Belgium and Luxembourg are shown jointly in the Annex but would be shown separately, after further consultation between these members, in the final version of the Annex to be attached to the Resolution.

The data used in quota calculations have been corrected for five countries at the request of the authorities concerned. The effect of these corrections, however, rounds out for all but six members. The unrounded quotas, quota shares, and shares in votes of individual members resulting from the corrections are shown in the Appendix.

2. Paragraph 3 of the Communiqué of the Interim Committee issued on February 11, 1983 after its meeting in Washington, D.C. states that:

"The Committee considered the possibility of a special adjustment of very small quotas, i.e., those quotas that are currently less than SDR 10 million. It was agreed to refer this matter to the Executive Board for urgent consideration in connection with the implementation of the main decision."

In the light of the above, two forms of special adjustments are indicated in the draft Report to the Board of Governors for consideration by the Directors. These are as follows:

- (i) The proposed maximum quotas of countries with quotas less than SDR 10 million would be increased to multiples of SDR 0.5 million;
- (ii) the other alternative would be to raise the proposed quotas of these countries to multiples of SDR 2.5 million. Under (i), the total of proposed maximum quotas for these countries increases from SDR 89.5 million to SDR 92.0 million, an increase of SDR 2.5 million. As a consequence, the average increase in their quotas rises from 33.6 per cent to 37.3 per cent. Under (ii) above, quotas that are less than SDR 2.5

million are increased to SDR 2.5 million (two members), quotas between SDR 2.51 million and SDR 4.99 million are increased to SDR 5 million (eight members), quotas between SDR 5.01 million and SDR 7.49 million are increased to SDR 7.5 million (four members), and quotas between SDR 7.51 million and SDR 9.99 million are increased to SDR 10 million (three members). This procedure raises the proposed maximum quotas of these countries from SDR 89.5 million to an aggregate of SDR 105 million, an increase of SDR 15.5 million or 17.3 per cent, and as a consequence, the average increase in their quotas rises from 33.6 per cent to 56.7 per cent.

The impact of adjusting the quotas of these members in terms of changes in shares in total quotas is negligible as the increase resulting from (i) above is less than 0.003 per cent and that from (ii) above is less than 0.02 per cent of total quotas.

The proposed maximum quotas of the 17 members resulting from the above-noted adjustments are shown below:
