ACHIEVEMENT OF THE DEVELOPMENT OBJECTIVES OUTLINED, IT HAS ORDERED THE  
"CRAWLING PEG" SYSTEM TO BE INSTITUTED. THIS SYSTEM WILL BEGIN TO BE  
APPLIED WITH A 1 PER CENT CHANGE IN THE EXCHANGE RATE. REGARDS.
