In Decision No. 6921-(81/109), adopted July 30, 1981, the Executive Board extended approval, until December 31, 1981 or the completion of the 1981 Article IV consultation, whichever was the earlier, of the restriction by Cyprus on the amount of foreign exchange available for tourist travel, as described in SM/80/155 (7/1/80) and SM/80/166 (7/10/80).

The staff report on the 1981 Article IV consultation with Cyprus, which includes discussion of the retention of this restriction, is scheduled to be considered by the Executive Board in early 1982. In the circumstances, the staff proposes that the existing Board approval of the restriction on the provision of foreign exchange for tourist travel be extended until the completion of the 1981 Article IV consultation with Cyprus.

The following draft decision is therefore proposed for adoption by the Executive Board:

The Fund's approval of Cyprus' restriction on payments and transfers under Decision No. 6921-(81/109) is extended until the completion of the 1981 Article IV consultation with Cyprus.
