I have been instructed by my Government, representing the interests in the United States of America of the People's Republic of Albania to communicate to you at the request of the Government of the People's Republic of Albania, the following:

The Government of the People's Republic of Albania, acquainted with the Agreement on the International Monetary Fund and desirous of contributing to the economic development of and cooperation between peoples, has requested the Government of the FPRY to present on its behalf an application for membership in the International Monetary Fund.

At the same time the People's Republic of Albania has expressed its readiness to discuss with the Fund any necessary technical preliminaries related to its membership. Accordingly I have the honor to request, Sir, that you kindly inform me of all such necessary technical preliminaries.

I shall appreciate it if you will forward the application of the Government of the People's Republic of Albania to the Council of Governors of the Fund for action, and if you will let me know of the result.

I avail myself of the opportunity to express to you, Sir, the assurance of my high consideration.
