Subject: 7th Operational Meeting of the Latin American Center for
Monetary Studies: The Contribution of Financial Systems
to the Economic Integration of Latin America

The Fund has received an invitation from CEMLA (Latin American Center for Monetary Studies) to be represented at this 7th Operational Meeting, at which the basic theme of the Conference will be "The Contribution of Financial Systems to the Economic Integration of Latin America". The meeting will take place in Mexico City during the period September 3-14.

The meeting will be attended by Central Bank technicians and officers of the various Latin American countries, including many of those later attending the Annual Meeting of the Fund.

It is proposed that the Fund be represented by Mr. Jorge Del Canto, Director of the Western Hemisphere Department, and Mr. Carlos Sansón, Assistant Chief, Mexico and Central American Division of the Western Hemisphere Department.
