Subject: **Organizational Changes**

Recent developments in Asia have affected the workload balance in several divisions of the Asia and Pacific Department. In order to help restore a better balance in the workload, a small number of countries are being reallocated among the eight divisions. Effective March 30, 1998, the new distribution of countries among the divisions of the Asia and Pacific Department is as follows:

- Division 1: Bangladesh, Marshall Islands, Federated States of Micronesia, Palau, Papua New Guinea, Solomon Islands
- Division 2: Malaysia, Maldives, Myanmar, Thailand
- Division 3: Australia, Fiji, Kiribati, New Zealand, Philippines, Samoa
- Division 4: Brunei Darussalam, Indonesia, Singapore, Tonga, Vanuatu
- Division 5: Japan, Korea
- Division 6: Bhutan, India, Nepal, Sri Lanka
- Division 7: Cambodia, Lao People's Democratic Republic, Vietnam
- Division 8: China, Hong Kong SAR, Mongolia
