Eight tables are attached to this memorandum:

Table 1 shows the powers that are conferred directly on the Board of Governors. These powers are inherently not subject to delegation. Some of them, however, have been expressly reserved under Article XII, Section 2(b) or Article XXVII(a)(1). Those that are expressly reserved are shown in the fourth column, but it must be emphasized that all powers conferred directly on the Board of Governors cannot be delegated unless there is an express power to delegate them. In the present Articles, no express power has been granted to the Board of Governors to delegate to the Executive Directors any powers directly conferred on the Board. Similarly, none of these powers could be delegated by the Board of Governors to the Executive Directors under the draft amendments in DAA/74/1, Suppl. 1. Under the draft amendments, however, certain powers could be delegated to the Council. These powers are shown in the last column.

Table 2 sets forth the residual powers of the Board of Governors that are reserved to the Board under the present Articles, so that they cannot be delegated to the Executive Directors. These reserved powers would continue to be not subject to delegation to the Executive Directors, but some of them would be subject to delegation to the Council under the draft amendments in DAA/74/1, Suppl. 1. The residual powers that cannot now and could not be delegated to the Executive Directors under the draft but would be delegable to the Council are shown in the last column.

Table 3 combines Tables 1 and 2, and thereby shows in the last column all the directly conferred and the reserved powers of the Board of Governors that could be delegated to the Council under the draft amendments in DAA/74/1, Suppl. 1.

Table 4 sets forth the non-reserved residual powers of the Board of Governors under the present Articles, i.e., all powers that are neither conferred directly on the Board or on any other organ nor reserved to the Board of Governors. In connection with this table, and Table 2, the following caveat that was included in DAA/74/1, Suppl. 2 (p.4) should be borne in mind:

"The 'residual' powers ... listed ... [are] subject, however, to the following important exceptions:

- (a) Residual powers reserved to the Board of Governors.
- (b) Implied powers (e.g., the power to invest as exercised in the past, to give technical assistance, to permit members to postpone the discharge of certain obligations).
- (c) Powers arising out of the obligations of members. For example, the obligation of members to collaborate with the Fund under Article IV, Section 4(a) for certain purposes means that the Fund has a power to collaborate with members for those purposes.
- (d) Powers that applied only to original members (e.g., the powers under Article III, Sections 3(b) and (d)).

Even apart from these exceptions, the list cannot be regarded as exhaustive. Many powers can be subdivided into component powers, including ancillary powers that are necessary for the exercise of a principal power."

All powers in Table 4 can be delegated to the Executive Directors and have been delegated to them by Section 15 of the By-Laws. It would be possible to delegate them to the Council as well under the draft amendments in DAA/74/1, Suppl. 1. If the same powers could be and were delegated to both the Executive Directors and the Council, there would nevertheless be a difference in the criteria that would determine whether powers should be exercised by an organ. Under Article XII, Section 3(a), the Executive Directors are responsible for "the conduct of the general operations of the Fund." The exercise of powers by the Council would be governed by Article XII, Section 3(b) of the draft amendments in DAA/74/1, Suppl. 1.

Table 5 lists the powers that are conferred directly on the Executive Directors under the present Articles. No change would be made in this list under the draft amendments in DAA/74/1, Suppl. 1.

Table 6 shows two new powers that would be conferred directly on the Executive Directors under the draft amendments. These powers involve certain relations of the Executive Directors to the Council.

Table 7 sets forth the powers that are conferred directly on the Managing Director. No change would be made under the draft amendments.

Table 8 lists in Part 1 the powers that would be conferred directly on the Council under the draft amendments; in Part 2 the powers conferred directly on the Board of Governors that the Board would be able to delegate to the Council under the draft amendments (see Table 1); and in Part 3 the residual powers of the Board of Governors that cannot be delegated to the Executive Directors under the present Articles and could not be delegated to them under the draft amendments but could be delegated to the Council under the draft amendments (see Table 2). In addition, under the draft amendments, the Board of Governors would be able to delegate to the Council any of the residual powers listed in Table 4.
