Subject: **Organizational Changes in the Statistics Department**

I wish to inform the Executive Board of my intention to make the following organizational changes in the Statistics Department (STA), effective September 8, 2008:

- The current Balance of Payments and External Debt Division I and Balance of Payments and External Debt Division II will be merged into a single Balance of Payments Division.
- The current Financial Institutions Division I and Financial Institutions Division II will be merged into a single Financial Institutions Division.
- The current Country Data Review Division and the Data Dissemination Standards Division will be merged to create a new division titled Data Dissemination and Review Division.
