Subject: **Final Report on the Status of Acceptances of the Proposed Fourth Amendment of the Articles of Agreement**

Attached for the **information** of Executive Directors is a final report on the status of acceptances of the proposed Fourth Amendment of the Articles of Agreement for a special one-time allocation of SDRs. The report includes all members that have accepted the proposed Fourth Amendment as of 5:00 p.m. today, August 5, 2009.

As of this date, the Fund has 186 members with a total of 2,220,817 votes. To meet the requirements of Article XXVIII, acceptances must be received from at least 112 members having at least 1,887,695 votes. As of 5:00 p.m., August 5, 2009, acceptances have been received from 134 members having 2,098,202 votes. Accordingly, the minimum acceptance requirement under Article XXVIII has been met.
