Supplemental Pay for Employees Deemed “Essential” During a Crisis

The Managing Director is authorized to provide supplemental pay to employees who are required to report for duty at Fund premises during a crisis involving a Fund closure and extraordinary health/safety risk, consistent with the example of procedures and policy in paragraph 6 of SM/09/236. This payment shall be equivalent to the daily rate of 50 percent of the midpoint of Grade A11 and shall be made for each day, or a prorated portion equivalent to the portion of the day, that the employee is required to report for duty.
