Subject: **Appointment of Mr. Hans Genberg as Assistant Director, Independent
Evaluation Office**

Pursuant to the Terms and Conditions of Appointment for Non-Contractual Employees of the Independent Evaluation Office (IEO) approved by the Executive Board, Mr. Schwartz, Director, IEO, wishes to inform members of the Executive Board of his intention to appoint Mr. Hans Genberg to the position of Assistant Director (IEO), effective August 2, 2010. Mr. Genberg's appointment is being made on a two-year fixed-term basis.

Mr. Genberg comes to the IEO with a distinguished academic record and recent experience in policy circles. He served most recently as Visiting Advisor for the BIS in Asia and prior to that as Executive Director in charge of research at the Hong Kong Monetary Authority and Director of the Hong Kong Institute for Monetary Research. He was a Professor of International Economics for many years at the Graduate Institute of International Studies in Geneva, Switzerland, and has also served as a visiting scholar or consultant for a variety of international organizations. Mr. Genberg holds a PhD in Economics from the University of Chicago.

The position being filled by Mr. Genberg's appointment was advertised early this year and attracted 108 candidates from 38 countries. Candidates for the positions were from a wide variety of academic and senior public service assignments.
