New Special Advisor Named for IMF

Michel Camdessus, the Managing Director of the International Monetary Fund (IMF), has named Shigemitsu Sugisaki, a national of Japan, as Special Advisor to the Managing Director. Mr. Sugisaki, who was born in 1941, graduated from the University of Tokyo and Columbia University. He joined the Ministry of Finance in 1964 as a member of the Minister's Secretariat. He held various positions in the International Finance Bureau and the Tax Bureau, and was appointed Personal Assistant to the President, Asian Development Bank in 1976.

Mr. Sugisaki rejoined the Ministry of Finance in 1979, holding a number of positions, including that of Deputy Vice Minister of Finance for International Affairs in 1990-91, Deputy Director General of the International Finance Bureau in 1991-92, and Commissioner of the Tokyo Regional Taxation Bureau in 1992-93. Since mid-1993 Mr. Sugisaki has held the position of Secretary-General of Executive Bureau, the Securities and Exchange Surveillance Commission.
